

Artist Call for Submission

Thorncliffe Park Community Hub (TPCH) will be opening in the 2025 new year and is seeking artwork to display in the new facility. The Hub is centrally located at 45 Overlea Blvd (2nd floor), and is a multi-service space that integrates health care, social services, and community resources. All artwork submissions should reflect the spirit and values of our vibrant community with the goal of creating a welcoming atmosphere, exhibiting diversity, and supporting local artists. Based on feedback from residents, community leaders, grassroots groups, and partner agencies, the Hub Project Team is calling on artists to submit artwork that aligns with one or more of the four themes listed below.

SUBMISSION CRITERIA

Themes: Artists are invited to submit wall art that reflects any of the below themes, recognizing that the community ranked these in the following order:

- Embracing community and togetherness
- Celebrating diversity, equity, and inclusion
- Honoring local history and heritage
- Symbolizing nature and the environment

Eligibility: Open to all artists living in the GTA. Preference may be given to:

- Local artists, especially residents of Thorncliffe Park and Flemingdon Park.
- Artists who demonstrate proximity, connection to, and understanding of the area and its communities.
- Self-identifying BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, Persons of Colour) artists and other equity deserving groups

Budget: Prices will be considered in the range of \$1 to \$1,200

Size: Maximum height of 5' or 60"

Timeline: Submissions are extended to December 31, 2024, at 11:59PM ET. Shortlisted artists will be contacted in January 2025.

Note: There are no fees or prizes associated with this call. All work will be considered by the Art Selection working Group, and some may be reviewed by the community via public survey. Selected art will be purchased and owned by TPCH (artist credit will be displayed).

- **Naming Format:** Name each image as follows: First initial, Last Name, and Image Number (e.g., ASmith1.jpg).
- Please include a short description or story about the artwork and/or the artist that will be displayed along the art
